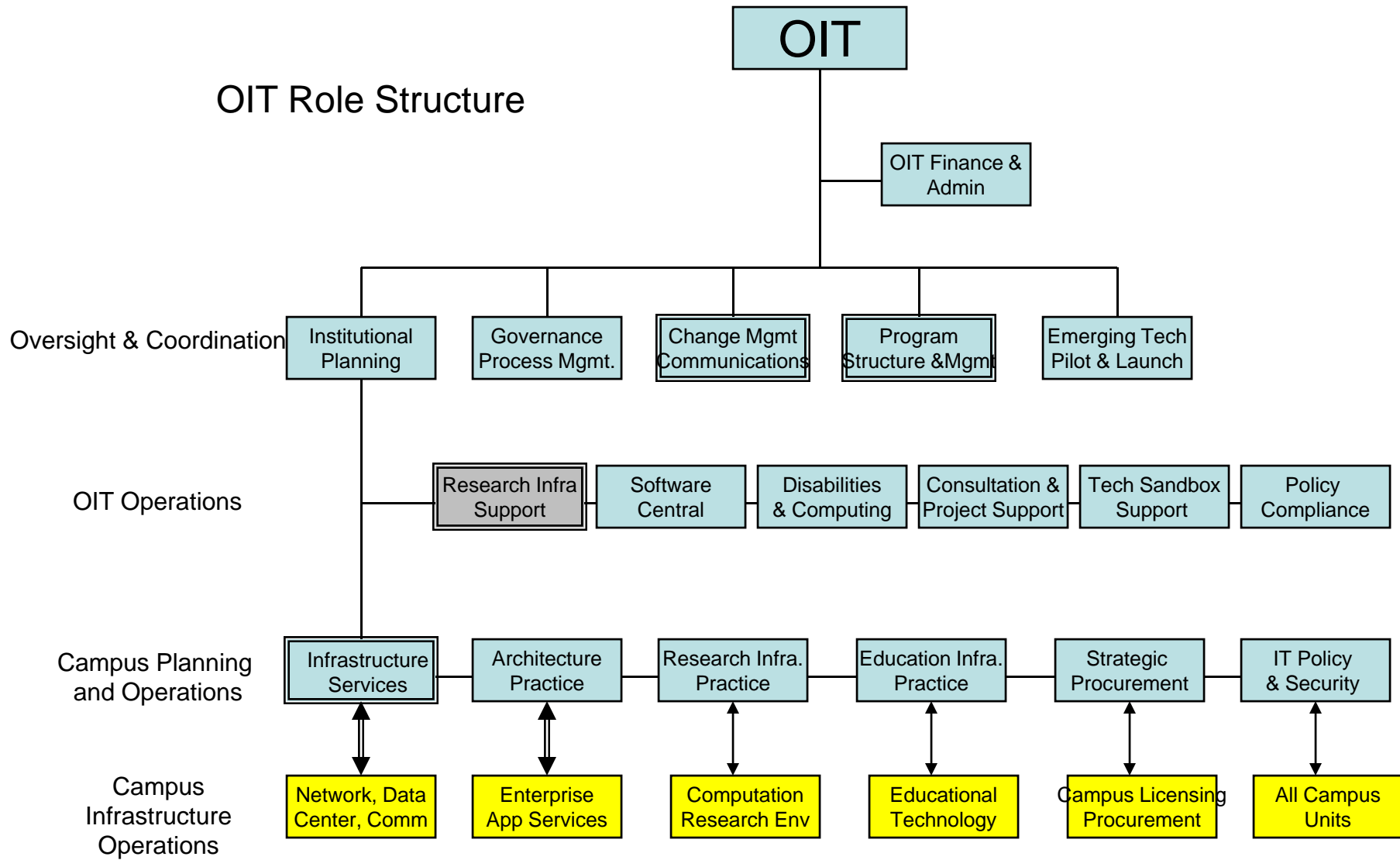


OIT Role Structure

Process

- Governance, visioning, decision making
- Establish process & practice
- Manage committee & campus structure
- Develop & manage documentation, communicate, build templates
- Training, certification

- Consultation (how to set up process, etc.)

- Analysis
 - Fiscal
 - Models
- Visioning process & campus understanding
- Staffing

- Consultation & external needs assessment

Pilot & Launch

- Facility
- Technologists (maintain base of operation)
- Service delivery (project management, reporting for public consumption, evaluation)
- Federated funding (matching, seeding)
- Business Development ("RFP" to campus, grant development)

Program & Project Management

- Track, monitor, nurse, coordinate
- Rent-a-CIO (gap fillers)
- Portfolio management & oversight (including fiscal)
- Keeper of procedure (for institutional)
- Consultation (e.g. dental clinic)
- Manage projects
- Procurement & licensing

PR & Communications

- Align with iCompass
- Mechanisms for reaching faculty
- Strategic communications plan (specify, develop content, deploy, develop communication channels) with a campus view
